



PROGRAMS TO HELP PAY FOR ADULT DAY SERVICES

Several programs are available to assist in paying for adult day services

Medicaid

If your income and assets are low, you may be eligible to have Medicaid pay for adult day services. Generally, your assets (with a few exclusions including your home) cannot be more than \$4,000 (single) or \$6,000 (married). Medicaid pays 100% of the cost of adult day services for those who are eligible.

OHA AT HOME Cost Share Program

Pays for a portion of adult day services for persons age 65 and over who need help with personal care (may include supervision only). **If your income is below \$37,650 (single) and \$51,100 (married) you are eligible. Assets are not counted.** Persons with higher incomes may be eligible as some medical expenses can be deducted.

Respite Services

A state-subsidized respite program helps pay for respite including adult day services for caregivers of income-eligible persons age 55 years and over.

Veterans Administration

An established contract with the Veterans Administration allows adult day services to be covered for eligible veterans.

Private Assistance

Many adult day programs including Saint Elizabeth Adult Day Centers offer reduced fees for persons with low to moderate incomes.
